During the worship part of our service the children will leave for their groups. Newcomers and visitors are most welcome in all of the groups. Follow the crowds through the door to the left of the worship group for:



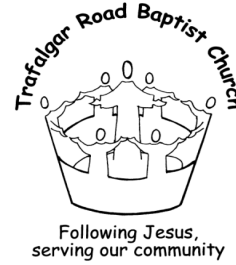
