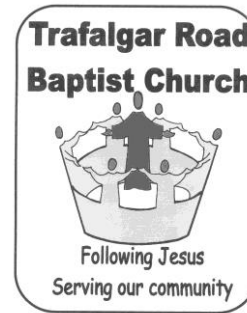

Sunday 16th June

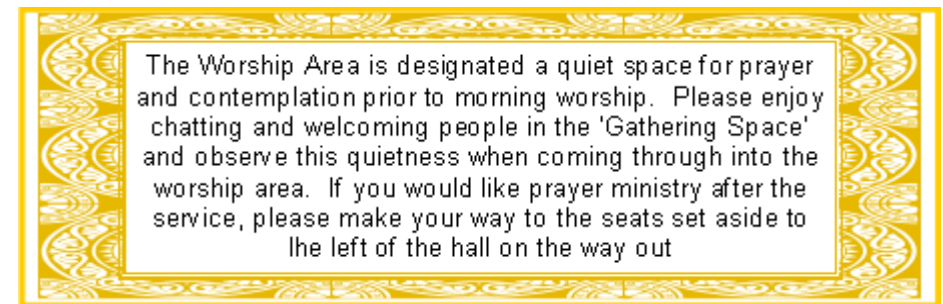
10:30am Morning Communion Service led by Peter White. Our Assistant Minister Rev Lisa Rainier will be preaching.

Church Meeting Headlines

- The £41,000 (including anticipated Gift Aid) raised from our recent Gift Day will be split 50/50 to repay some of the interest free loans from church members and as part of the tithe of our sacrificial giving (decided at the outset of our building project). Donations to The Centre and to East Worthing Baptist Church were agreed to form part of the tithe giving.
- Acoustic panels are to be installed in the worship space as a solution to the sound problems we have been experiencing.
- Steve Dallas is co-ordinating a small group to develop the Management of our Premises
- We agreed the use of our premises for 1 day per week over 4 months for the HCT Night Shelter for the homeless this coming winter.
- We agreed the use of our premises for 2 hours per week ongoing for a Food Bank (also an HCT initiative).
- We signed up as a fellowship to Project Cyrus – a BMS initiative to pray for North Korea.
