Horsham food bank — Access to the foodbank is by referral and keeping the profile of the foodbank high amongst referrers has always been a challenge. We're looking for a Communication Volunteer, someone outgoing and computer literate (no need to be an expert, comfortable is fine!) who communicates well face to face, on the phone and by email to maintain frequent communication not only with the referrers to the foodbank but also with the other volunteers, donors and the churches. We have been working with a digital marketing agency to set up a quarterly newsletter and this also needs to be picked up again, as well as visiting the foodbanks to talk to the clients to capture their stories. Up to a couple of days a week, medium to long term commitment, based at the office in Blatchford Road, could in part be done from home and would also require visits to foodbanks and potentially referral agencies.
