Songs of Praise in March (31st) has been CANCELLED due to it being Mother's Day and people being unavailable.



Christian Aid - The Big Shift Campaign - Asking HSBC to stop funding coal — Thanks to everyone who has signed the petition to HSBC so far. There will be one more opportunity to sign the petition next Sunday.

We, and others, will deliver the signed petitions on **Saturday 6th April**. We will meet at the Horsham Repair Cafe (which meets at the Quakers, Worthing Road) at **2pm**, and then walk to HSBC.

It would be great if perhaps 6 or 8 from TRBC could join us on the 6th. Our aim is to record the event with photos outside HSBC – these will be forwarded to the CEO of HSBC. The overall event should take 15 mins. Please contact Mark Francis (07808 574059) if you would like to join us on the 6th.

Link to Hope is partnering with Door to Hope to send as many bags of educational materials to children in poor communities in Eastern Europe as they can. These are some of the children who receive our shoeboxes and they often drop out of school and education because their parents cannot afford the stationery items that they require to take to school. The schools do not provide these items. Their target is 1000 bags by August 2019.

Kay already has some of the bags, so if anyone would like to fill one please talk to her. The items are specific to the list given so that each child is treated much the same. Every bag allows one child to access education who might otherwise miss out.

We still hope to do some shoeboxes later in the year.
