Her memorial service will be at the church on **Friday 6th February** at 10:30am.

Last week, the church **raised £1671.94** to help cover repatriation costs for Penny's funeral in Kenya. THANK YOU! This has given Penny's family in Nairobi huge comfort and relief.

Your generosity is greatly appreciated.

This amount has been transferred to the funeral directors, T Cribb & Sons in London, who are handling the process.

Together with donations from other sources and pending a gift from the Kenyan government, it is projected that the full amount will have been raised to cover both repatriation and burial costs.

Mission, Vision & Values

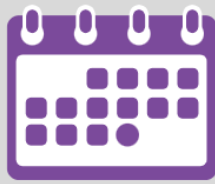
Our **Mission** is '**Following Jesus. Serving our Community**'
